Core Values

Davies will restart the new year with a “Partial” operating scenario following our established hybrid schedule beginning 1/7/2021.

Davies will reevaluate on 1/29/2021 when this quarter concludes.

Rationale for Restarting at “Partial” Operating Scenario

For These Reasons

- In-school COVID cases were not affected by previous change in operating scenario.
- Student performance and engagement has suffered greatly in the “Limited” operating scenario.
- This increases technical hands-on instruction, especially for seniors.
- Zoom attendance has been exceedingly poor.

Keep in Mind

- School-based transmission is not an issue at Davies.
- Davies has successfully completed all case investigation and contact tracing through partnership with RIDOH.
- Staffing is not currently an issue at Davies.
