Job Summary

- Must be able to work independently and determine work methods in accordance with standard industrial painting practices.
- Working knowledge of the standard methods and practices of spray painting and of the materials and methods used in painting or refinishing is required.
- Skills in the use and operation of spray-painting equipment.
- Capable of applying primers, smooth coats, and textured finishes as found on industrial parts and medical housings.

Duties and Essential Job Functions

- Prepares spraying equipment such as cleaning or adjusting spray gun.
- Report and maintain stock levels of all items required for the completion of duties
- Setting up paint equipment for spraying designated parts, mixing paint, maintaining spray booth, and spray guns.
- Some light repair which may involve inspecting, filling, and sanding parts prior to painting.
- Clean spray booth, replace filters and maintain work areas.

Requirements

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Must have two years' experience in industrial painting.
- Must have some knowledge with Spray Equipment, small hand and electrical tools.
- Must work in a team environment
- Must be able to follow safety procedures, written, and verbal instructions
- Must be able to speak and read English and perform simple math skills in order to follow instructions on shop traveler.

Physical Demands
