“...is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging State academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.”

# Federal Title 1 Requirements

## Main 4 Components of the Regulation:

- ▶ Increase accountability of everyone involved in the learning process, including teachers, administrators, students and family members.
- ▶ Scientific research, behind schools decisions, strategies and programs
- ▶ Parental input in your child's education.
- ▶ Notification about the professional qualifications of your child's teachers and any teacher assistants that may work with your child.

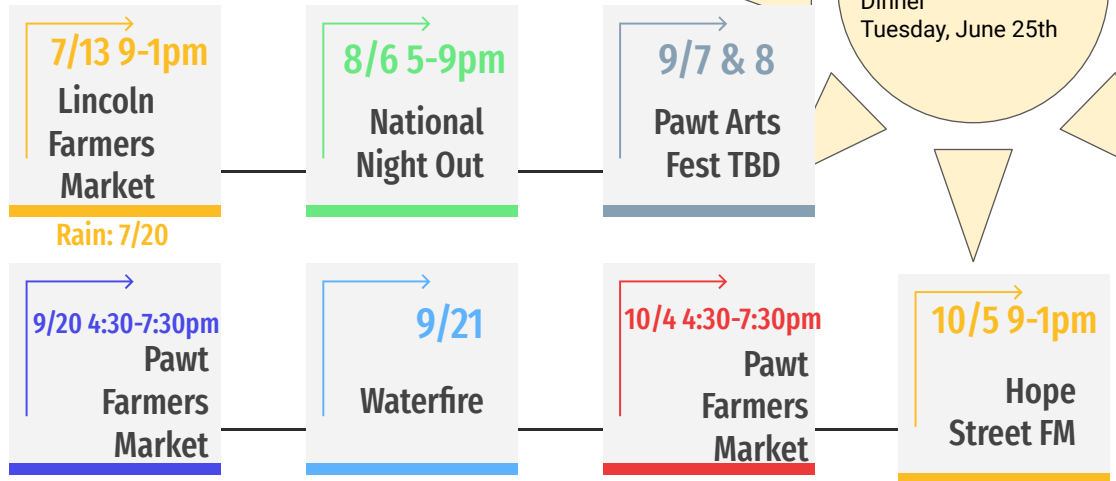
## Summer Meeting Dates

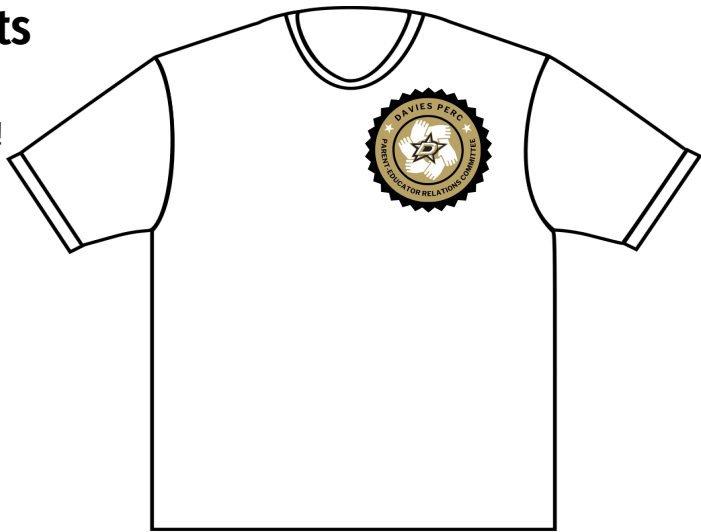

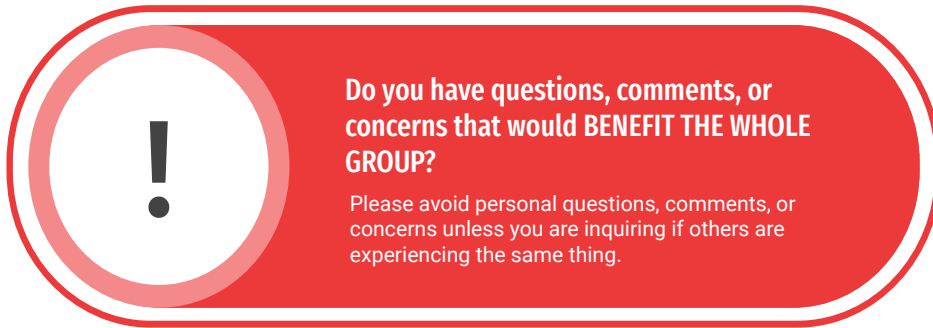
